What to expect on your first visit. If you are here in our office with an immediate problem, that will be our first concern. If you are here for a comprehensive exam to be followed by a consultation, then we will complete a medical and dental history, an oral examination and x-rays (if not already provided by a previous dentist). As a result of these findings, we will arrive at a practical treatment plan for you. At this time, we will also estimate how much the treatment will cost and how long it will take. Appropriate and thorough care are our foremost considerations and comprises not only the evaluation of current dental disease, but also its prevention in the future.

Our credit policy. The practice depends on payments from patients for services provided. As a condition of treatment in this office, financial arrangements must be made in advance. Dental insurance plans usually do not cover the entire amount of your bill. Your dental coverage is a contract between you and your insurance company, and, while we will fully cooperate in expediting your claim, you are ultimately responsible for your account. It is your responsibility to pay for any deductible amount, co-insurance or any other balance not paid for by your insurance company.

Medical and dental history. For your protection, we must know the condition of your health not only before treatment commences but also at each subsequent visit as well. We ask that great care be taken in completing your medical and dental history on the following pages of this form.

It may be necessary to consult with your treating physician(s) as well as any previous treating dentist(s) in order to complete your history.
